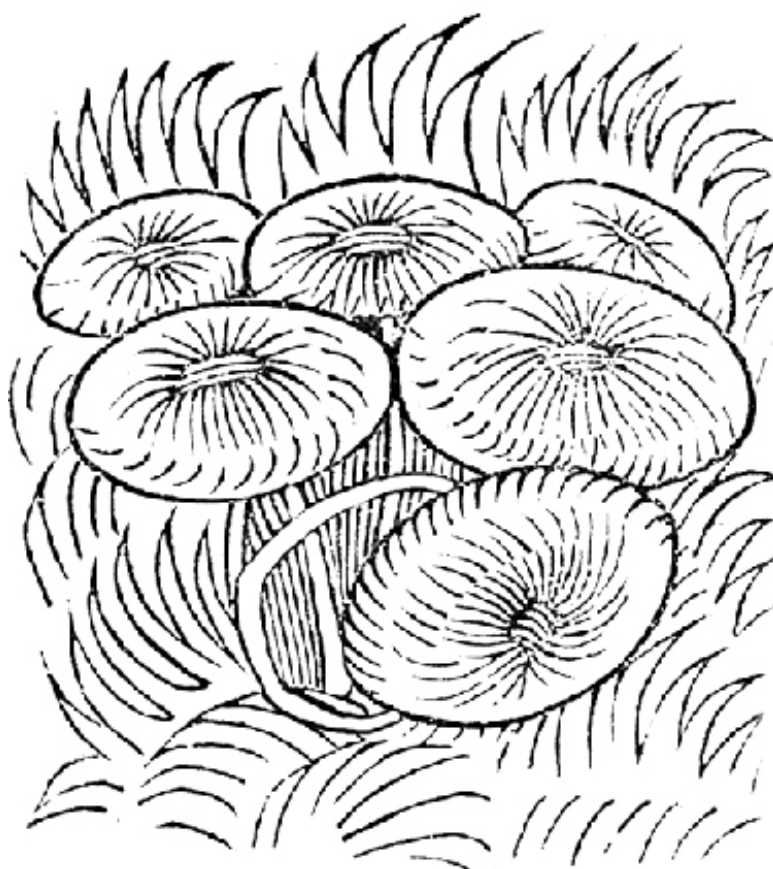

Utrecht 1976-2009. 7 vols and 8 supplements. 37.600 botanical works published until 1940. Stafleu and Cowan consulted the most important botanical and mycological libraries in the world.

UELLNER, Winfried: Fungorum libri Bibliothecae Joachim Schliemann. 3rd enlarged ed. Vaduz 1976. - Describes 1995 books and prints in the former Schliemann collection in northern Germany, then one of the largest mycological collections in private hands. About one third of the entries are reprints from journals

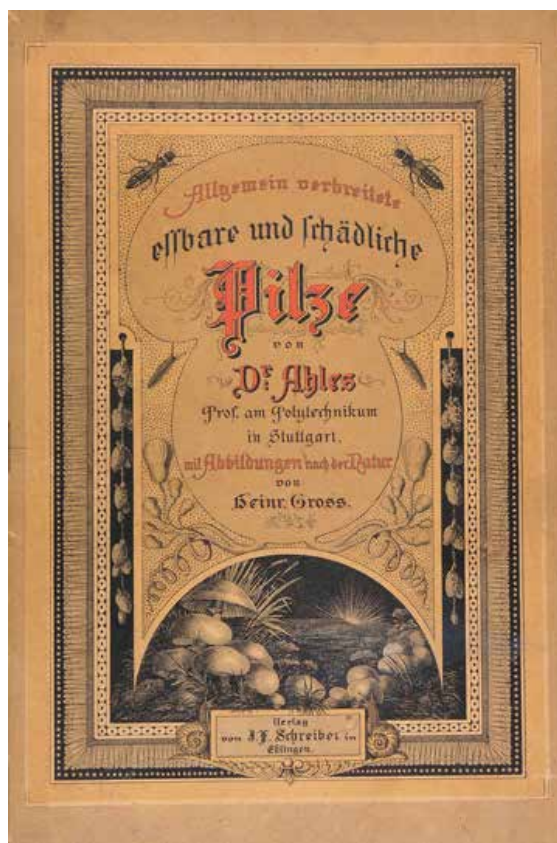

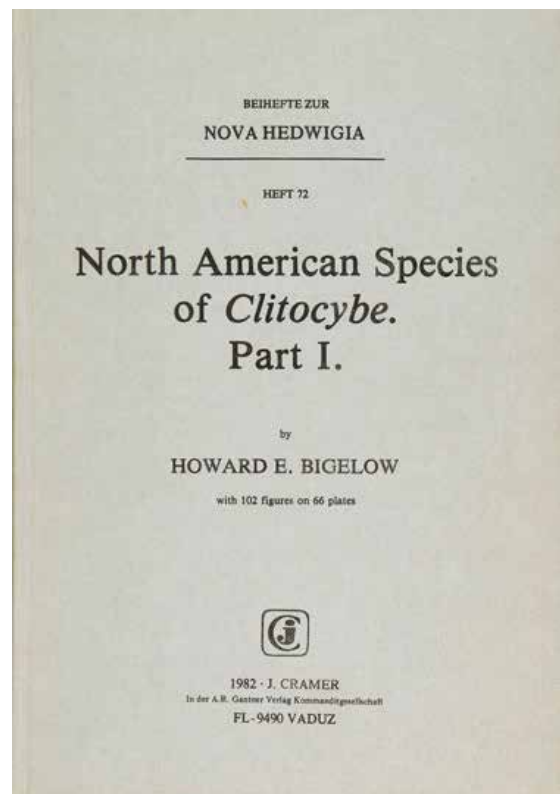

mycology. Bolton lived near Halifax, where he studied  
and painted ferns, birds and plants. He is most famous for  
this work with its finely coloured plates, describing many  
species new to science. The work is dedicated to the Earl  
of Gainsborough who gave funds to finance the project.

Volbracht 254; Stafleu 758. - A book of greatest rarity. Lazzari in „Storia della micologia italiana“ underlines the importance of the work, as it has been often quoted by Fries. Briganti was a Professor for botany and medicine in Naples. He died in 1836 and the work was completed and published by his son Francisco. It also was published in Memorie della Real accademia delle scienze de Napoli, vol. VI, 1852. Only very few copies with coloured plates exist. Even Lazzari describes it with „tavole in bianco et nero“, like this copy. The plates skilfully engraved, depicting finely the different species of Agaricales, including „Agaricus aegerita“ and other new species. A fair copy. Title soiled with spots, traces of ink and signature and stamp of the library of Dr. Eustachio Mignoli. One light stamp on lower margin of plate 1. Last two plates soiled and repaired. 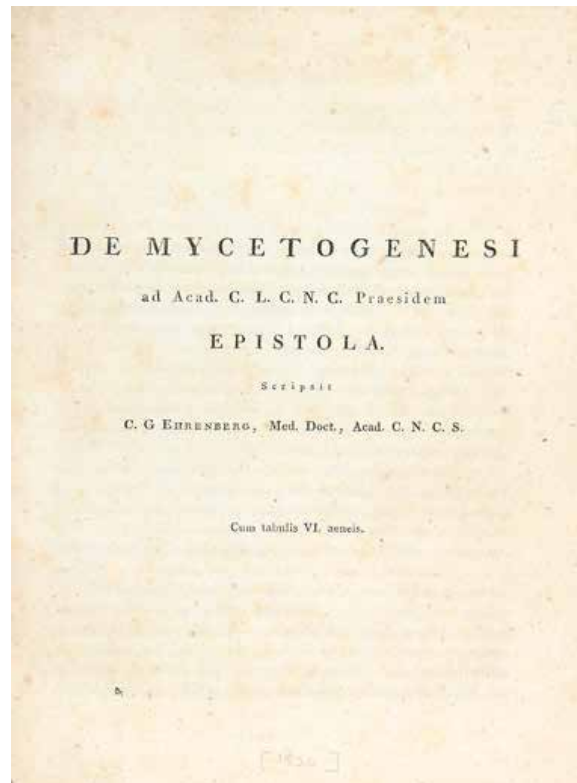

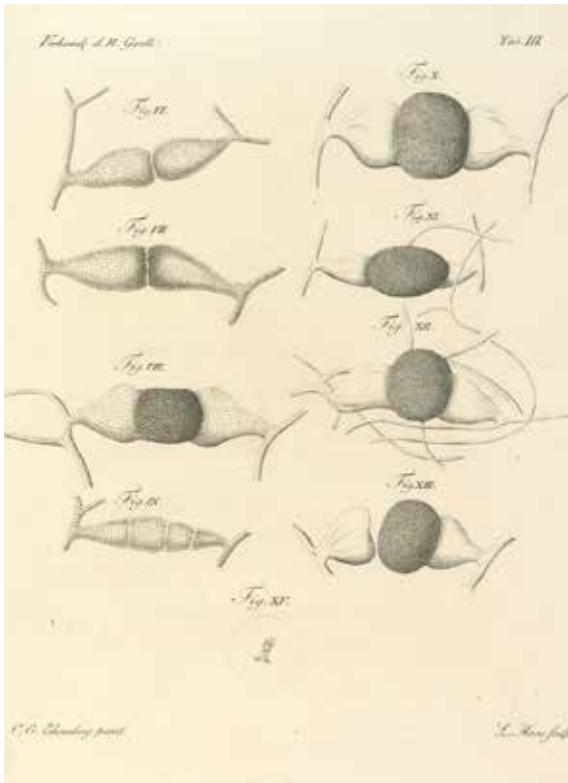

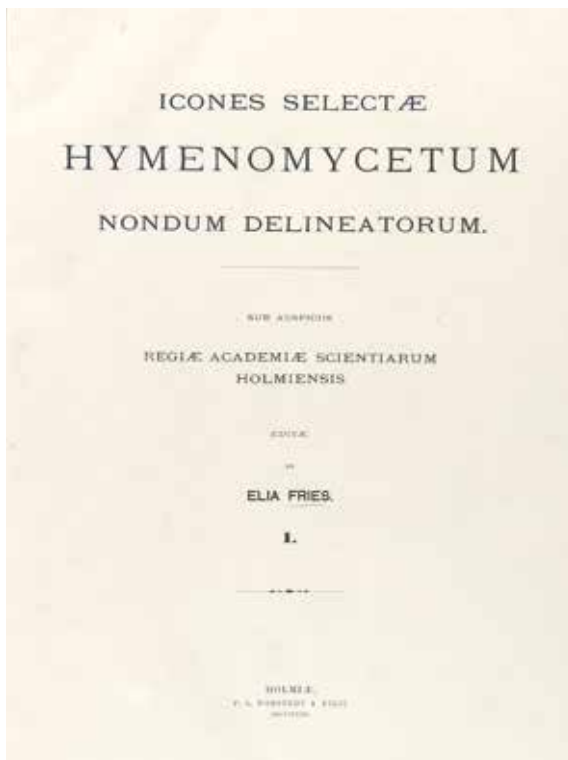

Franz Kallenbach (1893-1944) was a teacher and mycologist in Darmstadt in Germany, director of the mycological institute of the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Pilzkunde. The work remained unfinished at the end of Second World War. Kallenbach, an ardent supporter of Hitler, died when his home in Darmstadt near Frankfurt was bombed in September 1944.

Walter Neuhoff (1891-1971) lived as a teacher and Mycologist in Rellingen in Northern Germany. He specialised in Auriculariaceae and Tremellaceae and later in the genus Lactarius.

Julius Schäffer (1892-1944) was a teacher and mycologist as well, specialised in Russula. He refused to teach the racial ideology of the nazis and retired for health reasons in 1939. He died in October 1944 from poisoning after a supper cooked from Paxillus involutus.

The *Descrizione dei funghi mangerecci* was destined to a larger public, but there are new species described like *Bolturna fragrans*. The work is presented by Lazzari (*Storia della micologia italiana*) as „an unsurpassable model“ for practical and scientific description of fungi. Species are described in detail with Latin diagnosis, synonyma, names in German and French and possible confusion with similar fungi, followed by information about quality and use. Vittadini discusses the description of species in other works (Schäffer, Sowerby, Micheli, Trattinnick, Paulet, Bolton...) and the quality of their illustrations.

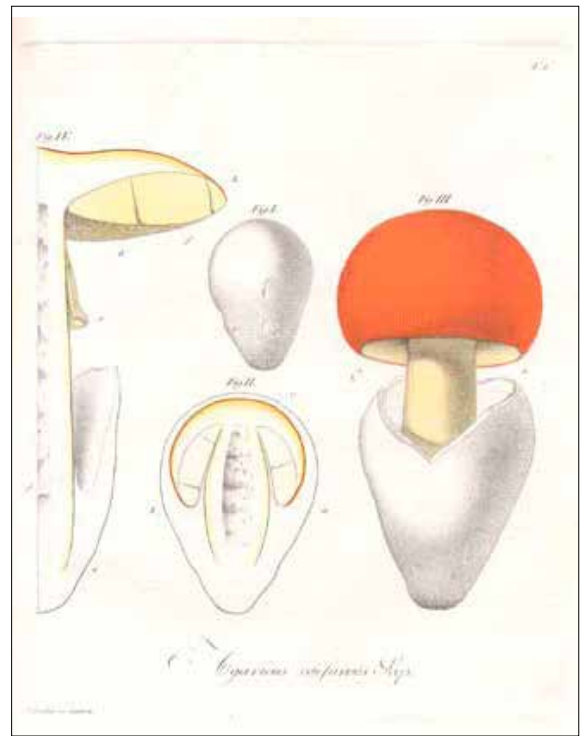
