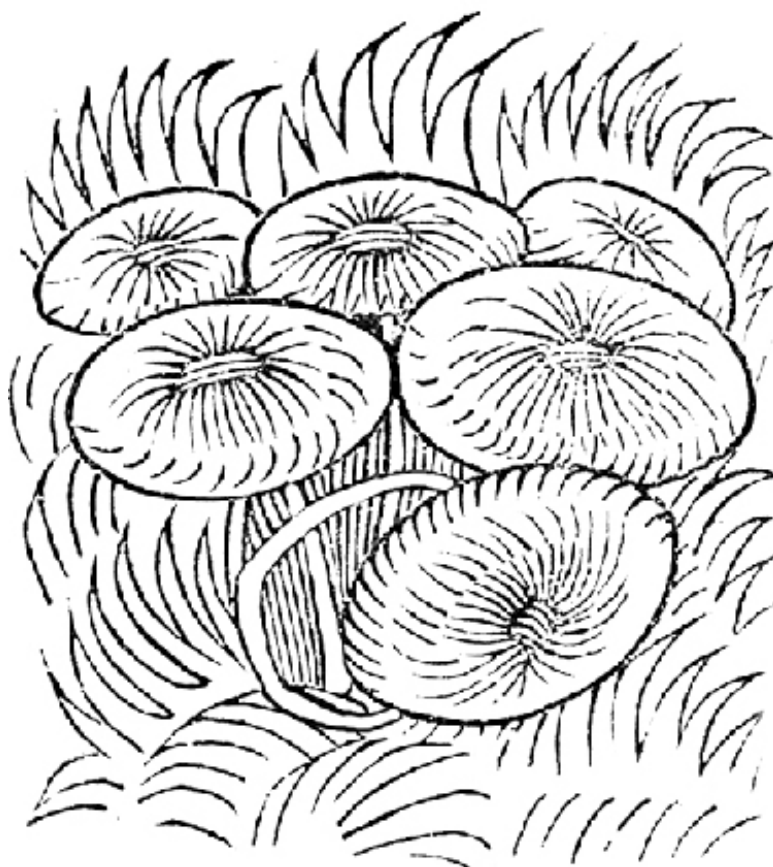

Vaduz 1976. - Describes 1995 books and prints in the former Schliemann collection in northern Germany, then one of the largest mycological collections in private hands. The works of Lewis David von SCHWEINITZ

Volbracht 12; Stafleu 75 & suppl. 1, p 61; Uellner 12; Pfister p 18; Nissen 1820 na; Junk, Rara: „Von außergewöhnlicher Seltenheit, wie wenige andere Werke der mykologischen Literatur“. - Highly important and extremely rare taxonomical work, describing many new species from the Region of Niesky/Oberlausitz in Saxony, close to the German-Polish border. The American botanist Lewis David Schweinitz (1780-1835) is considered as the main author. He was born as a member of the Silesian Herrnhuther-community in Bethlehem (Pennsylvania) and published the book at the age of 25, when his family lived in Germany, where he was as a teacher at the college of Niesky. Later Schweinitz became the founder of Mycology in America, publishing *Synopsis fungorum Carolinae* in 1822 (see Nr. 260) and *Synopsis fungorum in America boreali media degentium* in 1832 (see Nr. 261). His coauthor Johann Baptist Albertini (1769-1831) was a clergyman and later a bishop of the Moravian church, a minister and botanist.

The work proposes for the first time the spore colour as a taxonomical character. 1130 species are described, 127 presented as new, 93 depicted on the finely engraved and coloured plates. The copy is from the library of the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland, with their stamp on title. Text very slightly spotted, plates in fine colouring, some corners slightly soiled from dust. Bound in new marbled paper with gilt label on spine. 23,5 x 15,5 cm Euro 2600

Guiseppe Bayle-Barelle (1768-1811) was a botanist and professor of agriculture at the University of Pavia. First issue with two handcoloured plates after Bulliard. 18 further plates depicting the described species were announced in the preface („La parte tipografica di quest'opera con due delle più interessanti tavole colorate e ora sortita dai torchi ...”, le altre 18 che si stanno incidendo sotto la direzione dell'autore verranno pubblicate immantinente esse pure [... the other 18 are presently engraved under the author's supervision and will be published immediately]), but apparently never distributed. There seems to be only one copy with 20 plates, in Biblioteca Naz. Brera in Milano (Opusc. div. T 6: ZCC-III-34-7, fide Lazzari, personal letter). The book is inscribed on cover by the author to Antonio Gajoni, a physician and chemist in Nadro. A broad-margined copy in original paper-cover as issued by the printer with some wear. Émile Boudier (1828-1920) was a French pharmacist and mycologist, who dedicated himself at the age of 50 to his scientific work. According to Stafleu, only 125 complete copies of the Icones were printed. This is Nr. 77, signed by the author, with the list of 115 subscribers. A beautiful copy from the collection of the swiss mycologists F. and L. Marti. Bound in seven volumes - one with text and six with 100 plates each. Original titles and indexes for the plates have been loosely inserted. To the textvolume is added a handwritten index of species on 12 leaves. Very nice later half-leather with raised bands and gilt titles on spines, slightly rubbed. 31 cm.

Letellier was a physician and mycologist living in Saint Leu west of Paris. He collected fungi together with Gillet, but precise data of his life are not known. His first mycological works were published in 1826: Histoire et description des champignons and Dissertation sur les propriétés alimentaires, médicales et vénéneuses des champignons qui croissent aux environs de Paris. Three years later, he began this important supplement for Bulliard's Champignons de France, depicting species not mentioned in Bulliard's work and adding new taxa like *Boletus tuberosus* or *Boletus crocipodius*. The 108 plates, published over a period of 13 years, are numbered 603 to 710 (following the 602 numbered plates in Bulliard's *Herbier de la France*). A text-volume was announced in the printed covers of the 18 instalments of the work, but it has never been published. One of the original covers is inserted at the beginning of the volume. A second edition of the plates (unknown to Stafleu, cf. Volbracht No 1169), was distributed about 1840, with some plates lithographed by other printers.

According to Lazzari, Viviani hat prepared 105 plates with descriptions, but due to a disagreement with the editor the publication stopped with plate 60.
